I. Introduction:

College has adopted the New Educational Policy (NEP2020) from the Academic Year 2023-2024. All the admissions for FYBA will be as per the NEP regulations 2020. The students will be selecting their major subject from the first year itself.

All the students/parents must read the prospectus/notices carefully

IV. Important instruction to take admission to F.Y.B.A.

1. Students need to select one major subject at F.Y.B.A .from the subject list given by the college in the admission notice.
2. Students need to select one minor subject at F.Y.B.A .from the subject list given by the college in the admission notice.
3. Allotment of major and minor subjects at F.Y.B.A. will be purely based on the availability of seats and reservation policy.
4. Subject-wise capping will be followed.
5. The decision of college authorities regarding the allotment of major/minor and other subjects under NEP will be final. No queries will be entertained regarding the allotment of subjects.

NEP2020:(20 April 2023)

Under NEP2020, subjects are divided in to the following categories:

1. Major Subject(Major)
2. Minor Subject(Minor)
3. Generic or Open Elective Courses(OE)
4. Indian Knowledge System(IKS)generic, related to major subjects
5. Vocational skill courses (VSC)
6. Skill Enhancement Courses(SEC)
7. Ability Enhancement Courses(AEC)
8. Internship/Apprenticeship corresponding to the Major(Core)Subject
9. Field Projects/Community Engagement and Service corresponding to the Major(Core) Subject
10. Co-curricular Courses(CC) such as Health and Wellness, Yoga Education, Sports, and Fitness, Cultural Activities, NSS/NCC, and Fine/Applied/Visual/Performing Arts.

V. Reservation Policy:

1. Reservation rules laid down by the Government of India, Government of Maharashtra and SPPU will be followed.
2. **Only Students who possess domicile and caste certificates issued by the Government of Maharashtra, will be eligible to avail of reservation benefits.**
3. All students from outside Maharashtra will be treated as open-category students.

VI. General Instructions:

1. Students must read all the instructions carefully before filling out the Online Application (Merit) form.
2. Online application/merit forms for the program will be available on the college website, www.spcollegepune.ac.in/admission.php, after the declaration of the results of the Maharashtra State Board HSC examination.
3. The application/merit form fees are non-refundable.
4. Students should provide the correct information at the time of filling up the merit form. If any incorrect information is provided, such students will not be considered in the admissions process. Their claim for admission will be cancelled.
5. All the notices regarding the admissions process will be published on the college website. Students should browse the college website regularly.

6. The college administration will not be responsible if any student fails to check the notices and does not take admission within the stipulated period given to him/her. Students who fail to complete the admission procedure within the stipulated time will not have any claim on the said admission.
7. Students who have not filled out the application/merit form will not be eligible for admission.
8. Students can choose from 2 media of instruction available in the college i.e. English and Marathi.
9. A General Order of Merit will be displayed on the college website.

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VII. Admission Process:

The entire admission process will be conducted online only. Details regarding the admission process will be uploaded to the college website's admission notices.

General Order of Merit:

1. A General Order of Merit will be prepared and displayed separately for Marathi and English medium.
2. The General Order of Merit will include the name of the student, the percentage of marks obtained in the XII examination, reservation category, special category.
3. All students will be given two days to make corrections to their application/merit forms. All fields can be corrected, including preferences. At this point, the form will be open only to those who have previously filled up; new forms cannot be filled up.
4. **Name appearing in the general order of merit does not imply admission to the program.**

Mode of Admission:

1. The **First Merit List**, based on merit and reservation, will be displayed on the College Website after the General Order of Merit List.
2. Preference will be given to those who have cleared the 12th Standard examinations in the most recent Academic Year.
3. The admission form will be opened for only those students whose names appear on the First Merit List. Students should fill out the online Admission form and come to the college for admission with all the necessary documents. **The students should complete the admission procedure as given below. In case of vacancies, display of second merit list/third merit list/counseling round will be conducted as per the requirement and admission will be given as per the norms.** Details regarding the admission process—date, time, subject selection etc. will be uploaded on the college website.
4. **On ce all av ail ables eats are filled, no queries will be entertained.**
5. Admission to the non-grant (unaided) division will begin after the grant-in-aid admissions.
6. In the event of a cancellation of admission from the Grant-in-Aid division, admissions from the non-grant division may be transferred to the Grant-in-Aid division as per the reservation and merit rules.

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Admission form, document verification, payment of fees and confirmation of admission:

The admission form link will be made available **only** to the students listed in the merit list.

1. Students should keep soft copies of all the required documents for uploading while filling out the admission form.
2. Once online document verification is completed, **fee payment access** will be activated and students should pay entire fees immediately through **online mode**.
3. After completing the admissions process, students should submit a hard copy of their admission form along with **self-attested true copies** of all the relevant documents and fee payment receipts to the college immediately.
4. The admission status will be treated as confirmed only after **payment of fees and submission of necessary documents** (ex. LC, photocopies of the XII-mark sheet, caste certificate, caste validity, non-creamy layer, ex-serviceman, etc., or other relevant certificates as applicable).
5. Students must submit LC and other relevant documents at the time of document submission. If any student doesn't have LC at the time of admission an undertaking must be submitted indicating that he/she will submit it within one week from the date of admission. This provision is only for genuine cases. If LC is not submitted within the time, the admission will be cancelled and the seat will be made open to the next eligible candidates.

Scholarship/Free-ship Form:

Students seeking any concessions in fees (Reservation categories – SC/ST/NT/OBC/EWS etc.) will be required to fill out the scholarship/free-ship form after admissions on the MAHA-DBT portal without fail. In case students fail to fill out the form on time and/or if the form is not approved by the government, they will have to make a full payment for the admitted course (open category payment).

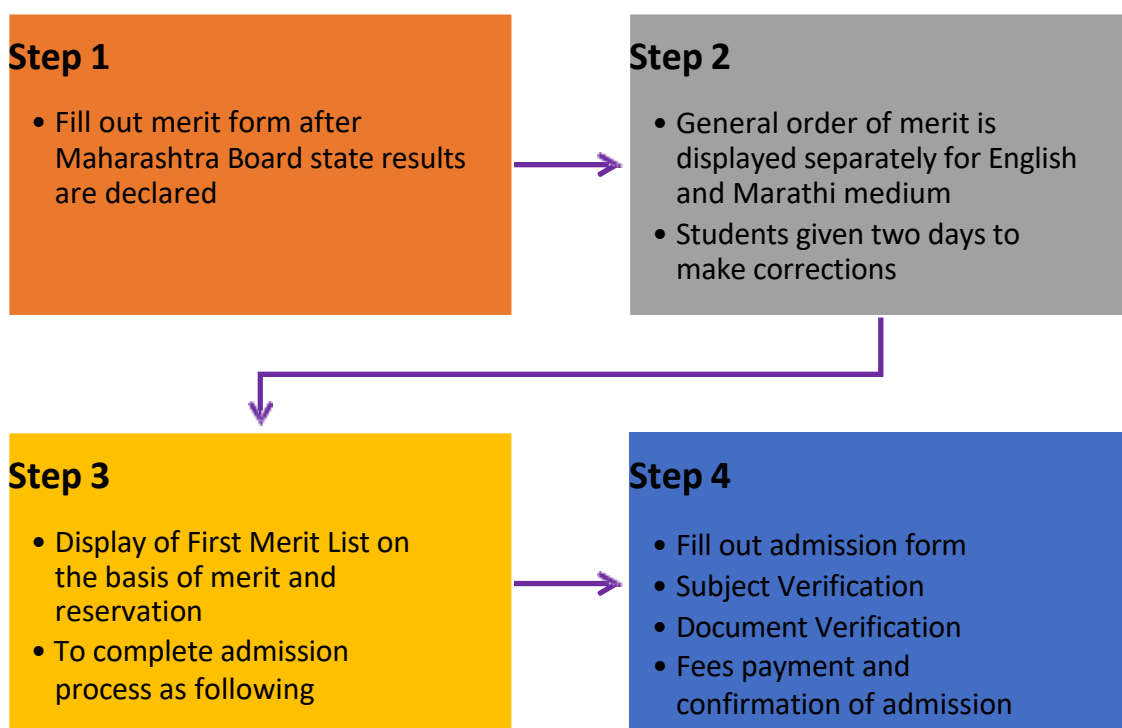
Admission cancellation procedure, as per the ERP process:

Students can fill the admission cancellation form from their student ERP login. Once approved, the account department will initiate a refund procedure for the fees. After cancellation, fees will be refunded online as per the rules.

The college holds the right to:

1. Change admission policies and rules.
2. All location of seats for major, minor, open elective and other subjects. (Grant-in-Aid and non-grant).
3. Change in the allotment of major/minor/open elective/other subjects under NEPs as per availability.
